

SINGLE STREAM RECYCLABLES: Includes Plastic containers, Steel (tin), Aluminum, Glass Containers, Cardboard, Magazines, News and Other Paper. **NO PLASTIC BAGS, PLASTIC PLATES, OR PLASTIC CUPS.** Place in container marked for recycling. Recyclables are collected on your regular trash day.

HOLIDAY: ○ indicates Holidays. Trash will be collected the next working day. Recyclables collected the following week, on your regular trash day. **EXCEPTION:** TRASH AND RECYCLES WILL BE COLLECTED ON DECEMBER 27.

BULK: □ indicates METAL ONLY pick-up EXAMPLE stove, refrigerator, air conditioners and bikes.

(NO WOOD, FURNITURE etc.) A scheduled appointment is necessary, call Public Works Dept. 609-884-0898

WHAT TO RECYCLE: Newspapers (with inserts), magazines, office paper, junk mail, telephone and paperback books, corrugated boxes, Kraft grocery bags and clipboard (such as dry food boxes with liners removed, **pizza boxes** and powdered detergent boxes). Aluminum, Aluminum foil and trays, tin, bimetal and steel cans (soup, tuna, dog and cat food, vegetables, sauces). Any plastic bottles, jars and jugs imprinted with recycling #1 thru #7 on bottom, including food and beverage bottles, empty plastic medicine bottles, beauty and cleaning products. **PLASTIC CONTAINER** that is non-rigid such as clean margarine tubs, microwave trays, household product containers, buckets, and landscape pots, (5 gallons or less in size).
GLASS CONTAINERS: Food & Beverage including clear, green and brown bottles.

HOW TO RECYCLE: Empty contents, rinse containers and remove lids. Place lids in trash .Place recyclable containers in can.

***** DO NOT PUT RECYCLES IN GROCERY OR PLASTIC BAGS. *****

****DO NOT RECYCLE:** PLASTIC BAGS, CUPS, PLATES, STYROFOAM, POLYSTYRENE EGG CARTONS, WAX-COATED MATERIALS, WINDOW GLASS, PLASTIC AND GLASS DRINKING GLASSES, LIGHTBULBS.
