SINGLE STREAM RECYCLABLES: Includes Paper and Cardboard: Bottles, Jars, Jugs and Food Containers that are Plastic, Aluminum, Steel/Tin & Glass. Place all together in one container marked with a recycling sticker. **NO PLASTIC BAGS, PLASTIC PLATES, OR PLASTIC CUPS.** Recyclables are collected on your regular trash day.

HOLIDAY: ○ indicates Holidays. Trash will be collected the next working day. Recyclables collected the following week, on your regular trash day. **EXCEPTIONS:** Trash and recycles will be collected Feb. 14, and Dec. 26, 2017. Thanksgiving holiday Nov. 23 and Nov. 24 Trash only will be collected Nov. 27.

BULK: □ indicates METAL ONLY pick-up EXAMPLE stove, refrigerator, air conditioners and bikes.

(NO WOOD, FURNITURE etc.) A scheduled appointment is necessary, call Public Works Dept. 609-884-0898

Recycle Right! Recycle paper, cardboard, bottles, jars, jugs, clean pizza boxes, and food Containers that are plastic, aluminum, steel/tin & glass. Hard plastic containers up to 5 gallons. Place all together in one container. **DO NOT** recycle plastic bags, cups, plates, styrofoam, polystyrene egg cartons, wax-coated materials, window glass.

DO NOT put recyclables in plastic bags!

Plastic bags from supermarkets can be taken back to supermarkets that have containers for "Recycling Plastic Bags"

VEHICLE STICKERS

- Proof of **LOWER TOWNSHIP RESIDENCY** is required.
- Limit One (1) sticker per household per year. Lost stickers will not be replaced.
- Stickers must be affixed to vehicle. If not, proof of residency must be provided.

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS for the recycling yard

HOUSEHOLD TRASH: **refrigerator garbage**, styrofoam, pool covers, etc.

HOUSEHOLD RECYCLES: Plastics, metals, aluminum cans, glass, cardboard, papers, rigid plastic toys, etc.

HOUSEHOLD APPLIANCES: Refrigerator, air conditioner, emptied lawnmowers, BBQ grills, metal vacuum cleaners, metal poles (without concrete), etc.

BRANCHES: Seven (7) feet in length & six (6) inches in diameter or less.

LEAVES: Garden debris.

RECHARGABLE BATTERIES: Drop off inside Recycling Center office during business hours- **Monday thru Friday 7a.m. to 3p.m.** Single use batteries can be placed in trash.

NON-ACCEPTABLE ITEMS for the recycling yard.

BULK ITEMS: Furniture, mattress/box spring, picnic tables, etc.

HAZARDOUS WASTE: Paint, gas, kerosene, anti-freeze, etc.

TIRES

BUILDING MATERIAL: Ex. shingles, lumber, sheetrock, paneling, wood, pallets, windows, doors, garage doors, etc.

RAILROAD TIES AND LANDSCAPING TIES

CONCRETE: Bricks and cinderblocks.

STUMPS: Larger than 3" in diameter.

CARPETING: Padding

AUTO BATTERIES

Non-acceptable items are accepted at the CMCMUA Transfer Station. May require a fee. For information call 609 465-9026

Grass clippings and garden debris (no leaves or branches) will be picked up the day after your trash day. Place clippings in a CAN marked with a grass sticker. Grass stickers are available in the Public Works office. Grass clippings and garden debris will be collected starting May 1 and ending September 30.
