GABLES of Cape May County Continue to Keep Roadways Free of Litter

Cleanup programs play a big part in keeping local roadways clean and behind those programs are dedicated volunteers that pitch in to remove litter and debris.

The GABLES of Cape May County have been volunteering their time through the Adopt-A-Road program to keep the township roadways clean for over six years. The non-profit organization supports the efforts of individuals and organizations whose purpose is to promote, secure, enhance and protect the human dignity, integrity and legal and political rights of lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender persons.

The group adopted the section of roadway from New England Road to Bayshore Road and the parking area by Higbee Beach and a group of volunteers work to remove litter in that area two times a year.

“It is an enormous help to have this organization doing what they can to keep the roads clean,” noted recycling coordinator Linda Thomas. “We are so grateful for all that they do.”
