**Public Service Announcement – All Lower Township Public Buildings to be
Closed to the Public Effective March 17, 2020**

As per Executive Order #103 from the State of New Jersey, in an attempt to contain COVID-19/Coronavirus throughout the State, effective Tuesday, March 17, 2020, all public buildings in Lower Township are hereby closed to the general public until further notice.

Recreation Programs are also cancelled until further notice, while public parks will remain open.

Township Hall, Construction and Zoning Offices and Public Works will be fully staffed. However, the buildings will be closed to the public. We encourage anyone with Township business to please try to conduct that business via telephone or email.
