

Message from Mayor Frank Sippel June 17, 2020

Good evening, this is Lower Township Mayor Frank Sippel to provide an update on several items. As of this past Monday, the County had 113 active cases of COVID-19, 24 of which were in Lower Township. It was great to see our businesses open up for outside dining, giving residents a chance to relax and others the chance to get back to work. This coming Monday, June 22nd, the Governor is allowing hair salons, barbershops and public swimming pools to open. On June 29th the Motor Vehicle Commission will begin to offer behind the wheel road tests, and will also resume issuing new licenses and permits. The Township has collaborated with the Ferry Terminal to host several drive-in movies in the upcoming weeks, and the first movie will take place on June 27. There is limited space for the vehicles, so please call the Recreation Department at 609-886-7880 for additional information. The restriction on concerts and fireworks from the Governor's Office has now been lifted, so we are attempting to schedule concerts at the Ferry Terminal during the months of July and August. Additionally, we are looking at the possibility of having our Independence Day fireworks on July 3rd.
