ORDINANCE #2018-06

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE #2013-01; POLICE DEPARTMENT, OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LOWER – 1975, AS AMENDED AMENDING ARTICLE I, SUBSECTION 90-1

WHEREAS, the Township of Lower has established a Police Department pursuant to N.J.SA 40A:14-118, known as Chapter 90, Articles I through III of the Code of the Township of Lower – 1975 as amended.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Township of Lower, County of Cape May, State of New Jersey that the following changes to Chapter 90 be made as follows:

Section 1. Subsection 90-1 shall be replaced with the following:

**Article I. Establishment; Organization**

**§ 90-1. Creation; composition.**


There is hereby created a Police Department for the Township of Lower, County of Cape May, State of New Jersey, the head of which shall be the Chief of Police, and which may consist of up to two Captains; up to three Lieutenants; up to seven Sergeants; up to 40 full-time Patrolmen; and such number of civilian employees as the Township may designate.

Section 2. If any portion of this ordinance is determined to be invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, that determination shall have no effect upon the remainder of this Ordinance, which shall remain valid and operable.


Section 3. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance, to the extent of such inconsistencies only, are hereby repealed.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect 20 days after final passage and publication as provided by law.


