ORDINANCE #2011-08

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 90, ARTICLE II, OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP ENTITLED, POLICE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, Article II , Special Law Enforcement Officers, of the Code of the Township deal with Class I and Class II officers, and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has requested to increase the number of Class 2 officer from 10 to 12 which would require an amendment to Section 90-19, "Number of special law enforcement officers" of the Code of the Township of Lower.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Section 90-19 of the Code of the Township of Lower is deleted and replaced with the following:


Not more than 10 Class 1 and 12 Class 2 special law enforcement officers may be employed by the Township of Lower at any given time.

SECTION 2. All other Ordinances in conflict or inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed, to the extent of such conflict or inconsistency.

SECTION 3. Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, the remaining portions of this Ordinance shall not be affected thereby and shall remain in full force and effect, and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.

SECTION 4. Upon final passage and publication according to law, a copy of this Ordinance shall forthwith be certified by an appropriate officer of the Township of Lower.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after final passage and publication as provided by law provided.






