SHERIFF K9 DOGS TRACK DWI SUSPECT TO HIS HOME

On Saturday, January 1st at approximately 06:42 a.m. the Lower Township Police Department received a 9-1-1 call reporting a motor vehicle accident in the area of the Masonic Lodge on Seashore Road in Lower Township.

Lower Township Patrol Officers along with the Lower Township Rescue Squad and the West Cape May Fire Department responded to the accident scene, which came in as a reported "roll over."

The accident investigation determined that the vehicle, a silver, 1997, Infinity Q45, ran off the roadway, struck several trees and rolled over onto its side.

The vehicle was unoccupied upon police arrival and Lower Township Patrol Officers then requested assistance of the Cape May County Sheriff's Department K9 Tracking Unit.

A look up of the motor vehicle's registration number came back to the 200 Block of 4th Avenue in Cape May, New Jersey.

Cape May Police Officers responded to that location and the Sheriff's Department K9 Dog subsequently led officers to the 4th Avenue address, as well.

Further investigation led to the arrest of Sean P. Colameco, age 21, of the 200 Block of 4th Avenue, Cape May, New Jersey.

Colameco was transported to the Lower Township Police Department where he was charged with the following offenses following the administration of an alcotest:

Driving While Intoxicated
Careless Driving
Leaving The Scene of an Accident
Failure To Report An Accident

The incident is under investigation by Lower Township Patrol Officers, Donald Vanaman and Edward Edwards.
