Title:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 475, PARKS AND RECREATION AREAS, ARTICLE IV, FEES AND REIMBURSEMENTS, OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LOWER, TO ENACT REGISTRATION FEES ASSOCIATED WITH A YOUTH SUMMER CAMP HOSTED BY THE LOWER TOWNSHIP RECREATION DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the Township of Lower recognizes the importance of providing recreational opportunities that promote the physical, mental, and emotional well-being of children in the community; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Lower is committed to enhancing the quality of life for all its residents, especially by offering programs through its Recreation Department that supports and advanced the development and success of children in the community; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Lower believes that establishing a summer camp through its Recreation Department will provide a safe, fun, and positive experience that will promote a sense of community and provide needed recreational opportunities for children in the community; and

WHEREAS, providing an inclusive and accessible summer camp program ensures that all children, regardless of background or economic status, have an equal opportunity to participate in positive summer activities; and

WHEREAS, the Township recognizes that youth programs, such as summer camps, can play a vital role in reducing at-risk behaviors, improving academic performance, and promote/advance a sense of community; and

WHEREAS, in connection with establishing a summer camp, there is a need to modify the Township's current Recreation Department fee schedule to establish registration fees for families interested in having their children attend the Township of Lower Recreation Department's summer camp.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Township Council of the Township of Lower, County of Cape May, State of New Jersey, that Chapter 475, Parks and Recreation Areas, Article IV, Fees and Reimbursements, Subsection 14, Recreation Fee Schedule, is hereby amended as follows:

and shall remain in full force and effect, and to this end the provision of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.
