A SHARED SERVICE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE TOWNSHIP OF LOWER AND THE CITY OF WILDWOOD FOR THE PROVISION OF EMERGENCY MEDICAL AND FIRE SERVICES FOR SCHOONER ISLAND MARINA

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Uniform Shared Services and Consolidation Act, N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1 et seq. (the "Act"), authorizes local units of this State to enter into agreements with any other local unit or units in order to provide or receive any service that each local unit participating in the agreement is empowered to provide or receive within its own jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Lower has identified a need to procure usual and ordinary Emergency Medical and Fire Services for the area of the Township known as Schooner Island Marina; and

WHEREAS, the City has expressed a willingness to enter into a Shared Services Agreement with the Township for the provision of all usual and ordinary Emergency Medical and Fire Services for the area of the Township known as Schooner Island Marina; and

WHEREAS, in the spirit of interlocal cooperation, and in furtherance of the principles underlying the Act, the Township and the City have negotiated an Agreement and deem it necessary and proper to memorialize these terms, as set forth below, in order to outline their respective rights and responsibilities for the benefit of both parties.

NOW THEREFORE, the Parties hereto, intending to be legally bound, do hereby adopt and endorse the following agreement to outline their rights and responsibilities in order for the City to provide Emergency Medical and Fire Services to the Township for the area of the Township known as Schooner Island Marina:

- 1. PREAMBLE: All of the Statements of the Preamble to this Agreement are repeated and incorporated herein by reference as if set forth in full.
- 2. TERM OF THE AGREEMENT: This Agreement shall take effect on January 1, 2026 through December 31, 2028.

3. TOWNSHIP RESPONSIBILITIES:

- A. The Township will pay the City the following sums of money for the provision of all usual and ordinary Emergency Medical and Fire Services for the area of the Township known as Schooner Island Marina:
 - i. \$6,500.00 due on or before July 1, 2026 for the term commencing on January 1, 2026 through December 31, 2026;
 - ii. \$6,500.00 due on or before July 1, 2027 for the term commencing on January 1, 2027 through December 31, 2027; and
 - iii. \$6,500.00 due on or before July 1, 2028 for the term commencing on January 1, 2028 through December 31, 2028.

4. CITY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- A. The City shall provide first response for Emergency Medical and Fire Services throughout the area of the Township known as Schooner Island Marina.
- B. The City shall provide the same priority and the same level of Emergency Medical and Fire Service for calls received from Schooner Island Marina as is currently provided by the City throughout the City of Wildwood.
- C. Calls for Emergency Medical and Fire Services shall be routed to the City of Wildwood, and the City shall respond to emergency medical and fire service calls received from these locations immediately upon dispatch.
- D. In accordance with the Cape May County Mutual Aid Policy, in the event that the City is committed to prior emergency service calls/responses at the time that a call for emergency services is received from Schooner Island Marina, either the City of North Wildwood or the Borough of Wildwood Crest will respond through Mutual Aid to the emergency service calls received from Schooner Island Marina.
- 5. TERMINATION: Notwithstanding the foregoing, this Agreement may be terminated, on ninety (90) days written notice to the other party, for any reason or no reason, or if a provision of the Agreement is breached by the non-breaching party by notifying the breaching party, in writing, of the grounds associated with the alleged breach. The breaching party shall have fifteen (15) days in which to answer and cure said breach. If the breach is not adequately cured within that time, the non-breaching party shall have the immediate option to declare this Agreement terminated.

6. INSURANCE AND INDEMNIFICATION: The parties represent that each is insured for liability purposes and agree to remain insured for so long as this Agreement remains in effect. The parties agree, to the extent possible under the terms of their respective insurance coverages, to name each other as additional insured on such policies of insurances to protect against liability arising from the provision of services under this Agreement, and to maintain such coverage throughout the duration of this Agreement.

The parties hereby agree to mutually indemnify, defend and hold one another harmless from any and all claims, demands, liabilities, causes of action, complaints, suits (at law or in equity), damages, penalties, fines, judgments, losses, costs and expenses (including without limitation reasonable attorneys' fees, court costs, consultants' and experts' fees, and the cost of enforcing this agreement) (collectively "claims"), arising out of the sole negligence, criminal acts and/or intentional conduct of either the Township or City or any employees, agents or officers thereof or acting on that Party's behalf, related to, either directly or indirectly, the performance by such Party contemplated by this Agreement.

The Parties agree to submit a copy of this Shared Services Agreement to their respective insurance carriers prior to the execution of same. The Parties agree that during the term of this Agreement they shall keep in force a policy of general and comprehensive liability insurance that will insure each party against any claims for any actions or omissions charged against either or both parties during the term of this Agreement. Each Party agrees to cooperate with the other in the defense of any claim or claims assessed against either or both parties arising out of the rendering or non-rendering of services contemplated by this Agreement.

- 7. **ADDITIONAL SERVICES**: In the event additional services associated with this Agreement are required and/or deemed necessary, which are not specifically set forth within this Agreement, the parties are free to enter into additional written agreements in order to effectuate the intent and purposes of this Agreement, without the need for official authorization from the parties. The parties expressly understand and agree that any fees associated with additional services must be negotiated and agreed upon in advance prior to undertaking said services and prior to requesting payment in connection with same.
- 8. **ASSIGNMENT**: The rights and the obligations under this Agreement shall not be assigned by either party without the express written consent of the other.
- 9. APPLICABLE LAW: This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of New Jersey.
- 10. ENTIRE AGREEMENT: This Agreement represents the entire Agreement between the parties and may not be changed orally, and may only be modified or amended by a written statement signed by both parties.
- 11. **SEVERABILITY**: If any part of this Agreement shall be held to be unenforceable or invalid the remainder of the Agreement shall nevertheless remain in full force and effect.

- 12. WAIVER: Failure to insist upon strict compliance with any of the terms, covenants or conditions of this Agreement at any one time shall not be deemed a waiver of such term, covenant or condition at any one time nor shall any waiver or relinquishment of any right or power herein at any time be deemed a waiver of the same or any other right or power at any other time.
- 13. AUTHORIZATION OF OFFICIALS; COUNSEL APPROVAL: The parties acknowledge that this Agreement has been executed and sealed by officials authorized and directed to execute same on behalf of the respective Parties by duly adopted resolutions for such purposes.

WHEREAS, the purpose of the NJDOT-NJSP MOU is to support the law enforcement missions of NJSP and participating law enforcement agencies ("LEAs"), to memorialize the understanding of the Parties, and to provide a framework for the permitting, installation, maintenance, and removal of ALPR systems and/or surveillance cameras on property under NJDOT jurisdiction, including NJDOT rights-of-way ("ROW"); and

WHEREAS, the NJDOT-NJSP MOU sets forth the responsibilities of NJSP, LEAs, and NJDOT regarding the permitting, installation, operation, inspection, maintenance, replacement, and removal of ALPRs and surveillance cameras on property under NJDOT jurisdiction and ROW, and permits LEAs to enter into agreements with NJSP for such purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Lower Township Police Department is desirous of entering into a Memorandum of Understanding, a copy of which is attached to this Resolution, with the NJSP as an LEA in order to facilitate the installation and deployment of ALPRs on NJDOT properties; and

AUTOMATED LICENSE PLATE RECOGNITION PERMITTING, INSTALLATION, OPERATION, INSPECTION, MAINTENANCE, REPLACEMENT AND REMOVAL ON NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION PROPERTY

THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU), dated the 24th day of November, 2025 (the "Effective Date"), is made by and between the Lower Township Police Department ("LTPD"), located at 405 Breakwater Rd Erma, NJ 08204 and DEPARTMENT OF LAW AND PUBLIC SAFETY, DIVISION OF NEW JERSEY STATE POLICE ("NJSP"), having its offices at 1040 River Road, Ewing Township, NJ 08628 (collectively, the "Parties," individually, a "Party").

WHEREAS, the Parties' desire to enter into this MOU is to support the law enforcement missions of NJSP and Participating Law Enforcement Agencies ("LEAs"), to memorialize the understanding of the Parties herein, and to provide the framework for the permitting, installation, maintenance, and removal of automated license plate recognition ("ALPR") systems and/or surveillance cameras on property under the New Jersey Department of Transportation's (NJDOT) jurisdiction and control, including the NJDOT's Right-of-Way ("ROW"); and

WHEREAS, the NJDOT was authorized to enter the MOU with NJSP regarding ALPR and/or surveillance camera permitting, installation, operation, inspection, maintenance, replacement and removal on property under its jurisdiction and control and ROW ("NJDOT MOU") under the powers vested in the Commissioner of Transportation by law and as more particularly set forth in N.J.S.A. 27:1A-5 and 27:7-21; as well as ensure that its infrastructure is constructed and maintained with its Standard Specifications and Design Standards; and

WHEREAS, the NJDOT previously entered into that relevant MOU with NJSP to set out the responsibilities of NJSP, the LEAs, and itself regarding the permitting, installation, operation, inspection, maintenance, replacement and removal of ALPRs and surveillance cameras on property under its jurisdiction and control and ROW. By doing so, NJDOT looked to streamline the ALPR process and eliminate any administrative

burden associated with the numerous LEAs that seek to install such ALPRs on its property through the NJSP; and

WHEREAS, NJDOT and NJSP entered into that separate MOU (NJDOT-NJSP MOU) which permitted LEAs to enter into this agreement with NJSP;

WHEREAS, the NJSP is authorized to enter into this MOU under the powers vested in them by law, particularly as set forth in N.J.S.A. 53:2-1, which, among other things, grants it the "power to prevent crime, to pursue and apprehend offenders and to obtain legal evidence necessary to ensure the conviction of such offenders in the courts," as well as to "co-operate with any other State department, or any State or local authority in detecting crime, apprehending criminals and preserving law and order" and Attorney General Law Enforcement Directive 2022-12 ("Directive 2022-12"), as amended and supplemented; and

WHEREAS, the LTPD wishes to enter into this MOU as a LEA, and is authorized to enter into this MOU under the powers vested in them by law, particularly as set forth in N.J.S.A. 40A:14-118, Chapter 90 of the Township Code, and Attorney General Law Enforcement Directive No. 2022-12,

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants, terms conditions, promises and obligations contained herein, which the Parties acknowledge to be good and sufficient consideration to support this MOU and bind and obligate the Parties hereto, the Parties hereto agree as follows:

1. RECITALS

1.1 The above recitals are incorporated into this MOU as though set forth here in verbatim and shall constitute part of the consideration for this MOU.

2. DEFINITIONS FOR THE PURPOSE OF THIS MOU

2.1 The LTPD understands, accepts, and agrees to comply with Section 2 "Definitions for the Purpose of this MOU" of the NJDOT- NJSP MOU, as amended and supplemented.

3. POINTS OF CONTACT

The Parties shall provide each other with the name, address, telephone number, and e-mail address of their respective points of contact regarding this MOU. If a Party's point of contact changes, the Party shall notify the other Party within ten (10) business days.

4. RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE PARTIES

4.1 The LTPD understands, accepts, and agrees to comply with all of the responsibilities required of LEAs under the NJDOT-NJSP MOU, as amended and supplemented. LTPD also understands, accepts, and agrees to comply with all provisions of Directive 2022-12, as amended and supplemented.

5. SUBMISSION PROCESS

5.1 The LTPD understands, accepts, and agrees to comply with Section 5 "Submission Process" of the NJDOT-NJSP MOU, as amended and supplemented.

6. ALPR INFORMATION SHARING

- 6.1 The LTPD understands, accepts, and agrees to comply with Section 6 "ALPR Information Sharing" of the NJDOT-NJSP MOU, as amended and supplemented.
- 7. FEDERAL AND STATE LAW REGARDING OPEN RECORDS AND FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUESTS, SUBPOENAS, AND COURT ORDERS, FOR PRODUCTION OF INFORMATION OR RECORDS
 - 7.1 The LTPD understands, accepts, and agrees to comply with Section 7 "Federal and State Law regarding Open Records and Freedom of Information Requests, Subpoenas, and Court Orders, for Production of Information or Records" of the NJDOT-NJSP MOU, as amended and supplemented.

8. INFORMATION SECURITY, RETENTION, AND INTEGRITY

8.1 The LTPD understands, accepts, and agrees to comply with Section 8 "Information Security, Retention, and Integrity" of the NJDOT-NJSP MOU, as amended and supplemented.

9. COSTS

9.1 The LTPD understand, accepts, and agrees to comply with Section 9 "Costs" of the NJDOT-NJSP MOU, as amended and supplemented.

10. LIABILITY

- 10.0 The LTPD understands, accepts, and agrees that the NJSP and the NJDOT do not carry general liability insurance, but the liability of the NJSP and the NJDOT and the obligations of the NJSP and the NJDOT to be responsible for tort claims against each are covered under the terms and provisions of the New Jersey Tort Claims Act, N.J.S.A. 59:1-1 to 12-3 ("TCA"). The TCA also creates a fund into which the Legislature appropriates funds from time to time, and from which final tort claims are paid in accordance with its provisions. See N.J.S.A. 59:12-1.
- 10.1 The LTPD understands, accepts, and agrees that the TCA sets forth specific timeframes and requirements for filing claims against public entities including that notice, with all required information set forth in the TCA, must be submitted to the public entity within ninety (90) days of the incident.
- 10.2 The LTPD understands, accepts, and agrees that any claims against the NJSP and NJDOT are also subject to the New Jersey Contractual Liability Act, N.J.S.A. 59:13-1 to 13-10, appropriations, and the availability of funding.

11. SEVERABILITY

11.1 The LTPD understands, accepts, and agrees to comply with Section 10 "Severability" of the NJDOT-NJSP MOU, as amended and supplemented.

12. EFFECT ON OTHER AUTHORITIES

12.1 The LTPD understands, accepts, and agrees to comply with Section 11 "Effect on other Authorities" of the NJDOT-NJSP MOU, as amended and supplemented.

13. TERM

- 13.1 The LTPD understands, accepts, and agrees to comply with Section 12 "Term" of the NJDOT-NJSP MOU, as amended and supplemented.
- 13.2 In the event that the NJDOT-NJSP MOU is amended or supplemented, NJSP shall notify LTPD within ten (10) business days of such change and provide any necessary documentation. LTPD may terminate this agreement upon ten (10) business days' written notice to NJSP of such notification if it does not wish to be bound by the NJDOT-NJSP MOU's amended or supplemented terms. Otherwise, the LTPD must provide ninety (90) days written notice to NJSP before terminating this agreement.

14. ENTIRE AGREEMENT

14.1 This MOU represents the entire understanding and agreement between the Parties concerning the ALPRs, and no amendment or modification of this MOU shall be effective, unless in writing, signed by the Parties and approved as required by law.

15, NO THIRD-PARTY BENEFICIARIES

15.1 The LTPD understands, accepts, and agrees to comply with Section 14 "No Third-Party Beneficiaries" of the NJDOT-NJSP MOU, as amended and supplemented.

16. NO PRIVATE RIGHTS CREATED

16.1 The LTPD understands, accepts, and agrees to comply with Section 15 "No Private Rights Created" of the NJDOT-NJSP MOU, as amended and supplemented.

17. LIABILITY

17.1 The LTPD understands, accepts, and agrees to comply with Section 16 "Liability" of the NJDOT-NJSP MOU, as amended and supplemented.

18. ASSIGNMENT

18.1 This MOU may not be assigned or otherwise transferred by a Party without the prior written consent of the other Party. Under this MOU, no such assignment or transfer shall relieve the Parties of any of their obligations or liabilities, whether accrued or un-accrued.

19. NON-WAIVER

19.1 The LTPD understands, accepts, and agrees to comply with Section 18 "Non-Waiver" of the NJDOT-NJSP MOU, as amended and supplemented.

20. COUNTERPARTS

20.1 This Agreement may be executed in any number of counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, but all such counterparts together shall constitute one and the same instrument.

21. DISPUTES

21.1 THE LTPD understands, accepts, and agrees to comply with Section 20 "Disputes" of the NJDOT-NJSP MOU, as amended and supplemented.

22. AUTHORITY

22.1 The Parties represent and warrant that they have the authority to execute this Agreement and each individual signing on behalf of a party to this Agreement states that he or she is the duly authorized representative of the signing party and that his or her signature on this Agreement has been duly authorized by, and created the binding and enforceable obligation of, the party on whose behalf the representative is signing.

23. FURTHER COOPERATION

23.1 The Parties agree to execute such other documents and to perform such other acts as may be reasonably necessary or desirable to further the expressed and intended purpose of this Agreement.

24. ELECTRONIC SIGNATURES

24.1 The Parties agree that the execution of this MOU by electronic signature and/or by exchanging PDF signatures will have the same legal force and effect as the exchange of original signatures. By execution, delivery and performance of this MOU, each Party represents to the other Party that it has been duly authorized by all requisite action on its part. This MOU constitutes the legal, valid, and binding obligation of the Parties.



INTERLOCAL SERVICES AGREEMENT

FIRE SUPPRESSION SERVICES

BETWEEN	THE BOROUGH OF WILDWOOD CREST
AND	WILDWOOD CREST VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANY NO. 1
AND	THE TOWNSHIP OF LOWER
AND	THE COMMISSIONERS OF FIRE DISTRICT NO. 3, TOWNSHIP OF LOWER, COUNTY OF CAPE MAY

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Uniform Shared Services and Consolidation Act, N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1 et seq., the Borough, Volunteer Fire Company, Township and District desire to contract for the furnishing of fire protection services, and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the citizens of both the Borough and the Township to enter into this joint agreement for the furnishing of fire protection services.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises contained herein, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. FIRE SUPPRESSION SERVICES: The current volunteer fire department known as Wildwood Crest Volunteer Fire Company No. 1 shall provide fire suppression services ONLY to the Township exclusively for the geographical area of the Township known as Diamond Beach. This shall include all areas of Diamond Beach from Richmond Avenue to the base of the bridge known as the Ocean Drive Bridge. This shall also include the geographical area of the Township which is located along Bayview Drive. The Borough, through the Volunteer Fire Company, shall be the initial response for all

fire calls and fire suppression services within the designated geographic location, and the Volunteer Fire Company will respond to all fire calls and fire suppression services in the same manner, utilizing the same equipment and manpower that the Volunteer Fire Co. currently utilizes in response to such calls within Wildwood Crest, and the District shall be required to also respond on site to all calls. After arriving on site, as soon as safe and reasonably practical, the Township's police, EMTs and the District will relieve all Wildwood Crest units that are on scene. The District and/or Township shall have all reporting and post-response obligations as top documentation, claims, reports, etc. It is expressly understood and agreed to by all parties hereto that the Borough shall not be required to provide EMT or police services or protection. All dispatch obligations shall be that of the Township. Borough shall have no responsibility or liability pertaining to dispatch operations or dispatch communications. This agreement does not include any services from Borough to Township for annual or other fire, life hazard, smoke detector or carbon monoxide inspections, all of which shall remain the sole responsibility of the Township of Lower and Bureau of Fire Safety.

- 2. TERM OF AGREEMENT: The term of this agreement shall be THREE (3) YEARS from January 1, 2026 to December 31, 2028. This agreement shall be cancelled by either party upon written notice to all parties of cancellation ninety (90) days prior to the requested cancellation date, except that Borough may terminate this agreement upon thirty (30) days written notice from Borough to all parties of nonpayment.
- 3. CONSIDERATION/CONTRIBUTION FOR OPERATING EXPENSES: The agreed-upon cost of providing said services shall be as follows:

Year 1:

\$48,750.00 on or before February 1, 2026 \$48,750.00 on or before August 1, 2026

Total Year 1 \$97,500

Year 2:

\$50,000.00 on or before February 1, 2027 \$50,000.00 on or before October 1, 2027

Total Year 2 \$100,000

Year 3:

\$51,250.00 on or before February 1, 2028 \$51,250.00 on or before October 1, 2028

Total Year 3 \$102,500

All funds are to be made payable to the Wildwood Crest Volunteer Fire Company No. 1.

- 4. INSURANCE: It is understood and agreed that the Borough and the Township are currently insured through the Atlantic County Municipal Joint Insurance Fund, and the District is currently insured through VFIS. The parties hereto agree, to the extent that it is necessary, each party will name the other as additional insured, if required for purposes of this Interlocal Services Agreement. Each party shall provide, if required, certificates of insurance setting forth coverage and naming the other party as additional insured, with a proviso that any such policies cannot be cancelled except upon sixty (60) days notice to the other party. In the event either party ceases to participate in its insurance program as is in effect on the date of this Agreement, such party shall provide alternative insurance comparable to the coverage in effect on the date of this Agreement, subject to the approval of the other party, which approval shall not be unreasonably withheld, conditioned or delayed.
- 5. **TERMINATION:** This agreement may be terminated upon three (3) months written notification by any party to all parties, in which event the parties agree to meet and resolve all issues associated with such termination. This agreement may also be terminated upon the default of any payments due hereunder, subject to Borough providing thirty (30) days written notice to all parties of said default and providing an opportunity to cure the default within the 30-day notice period. Should said default continue beyond the 30-day notice period, Borough shall be entitled to issue written notice to all parties of termination.
