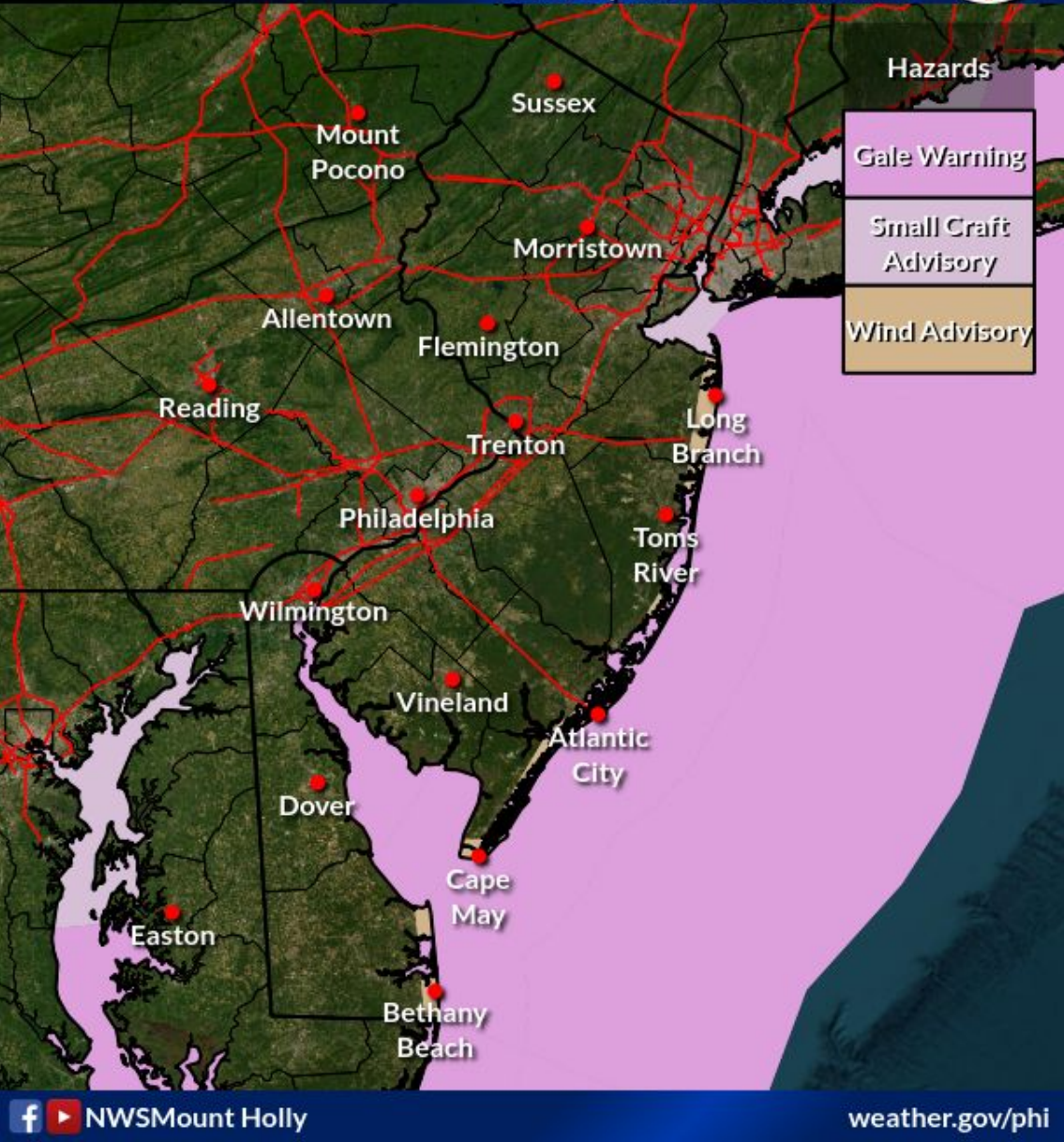

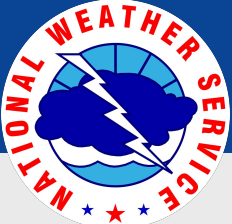

Key Messages

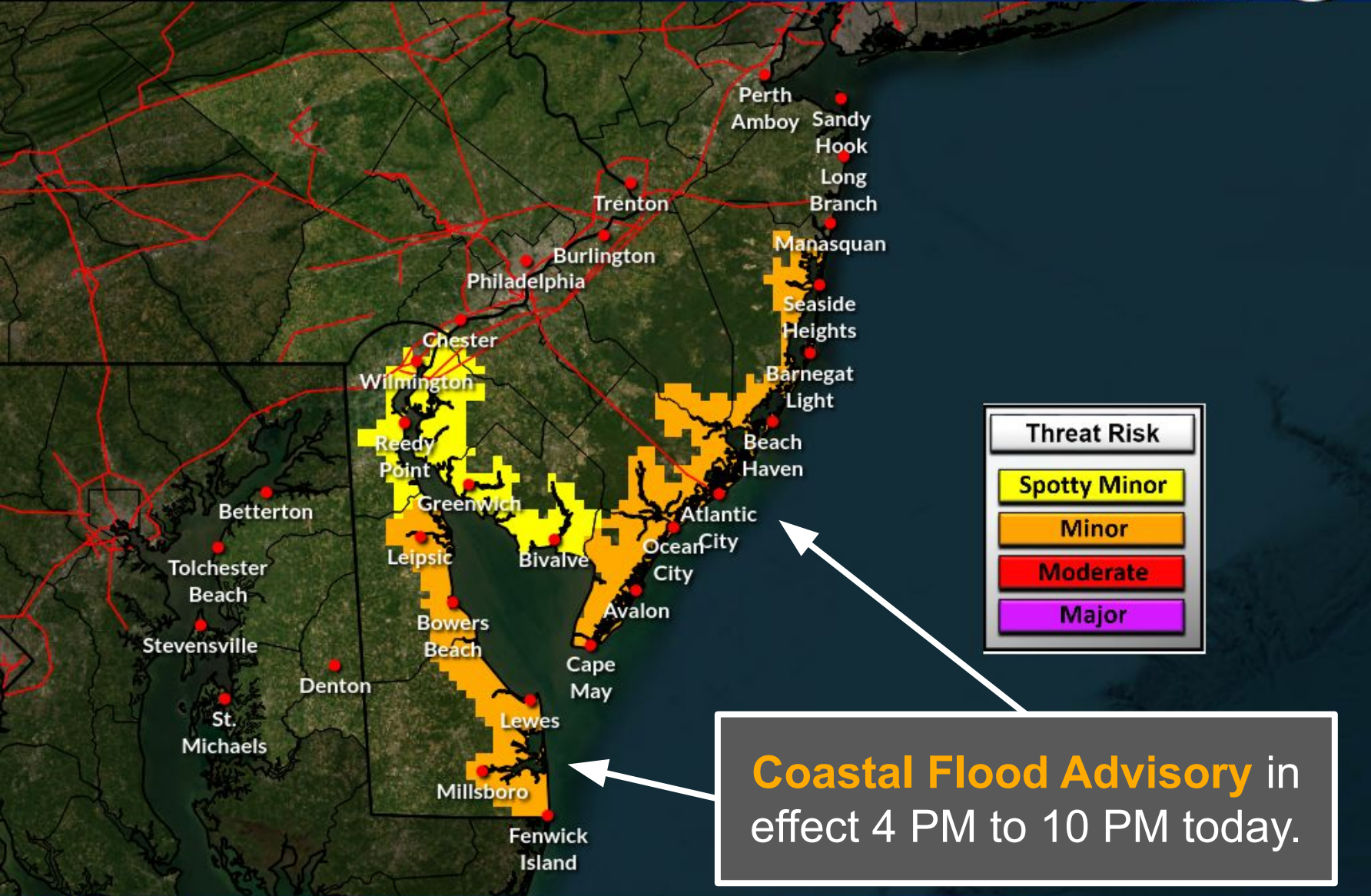
- **What:** Minor coastal flooding expected, mainly for most vulnerable roads and low lying areas.

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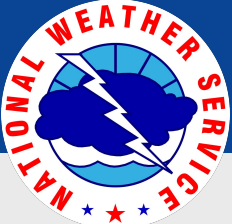

Key Messages

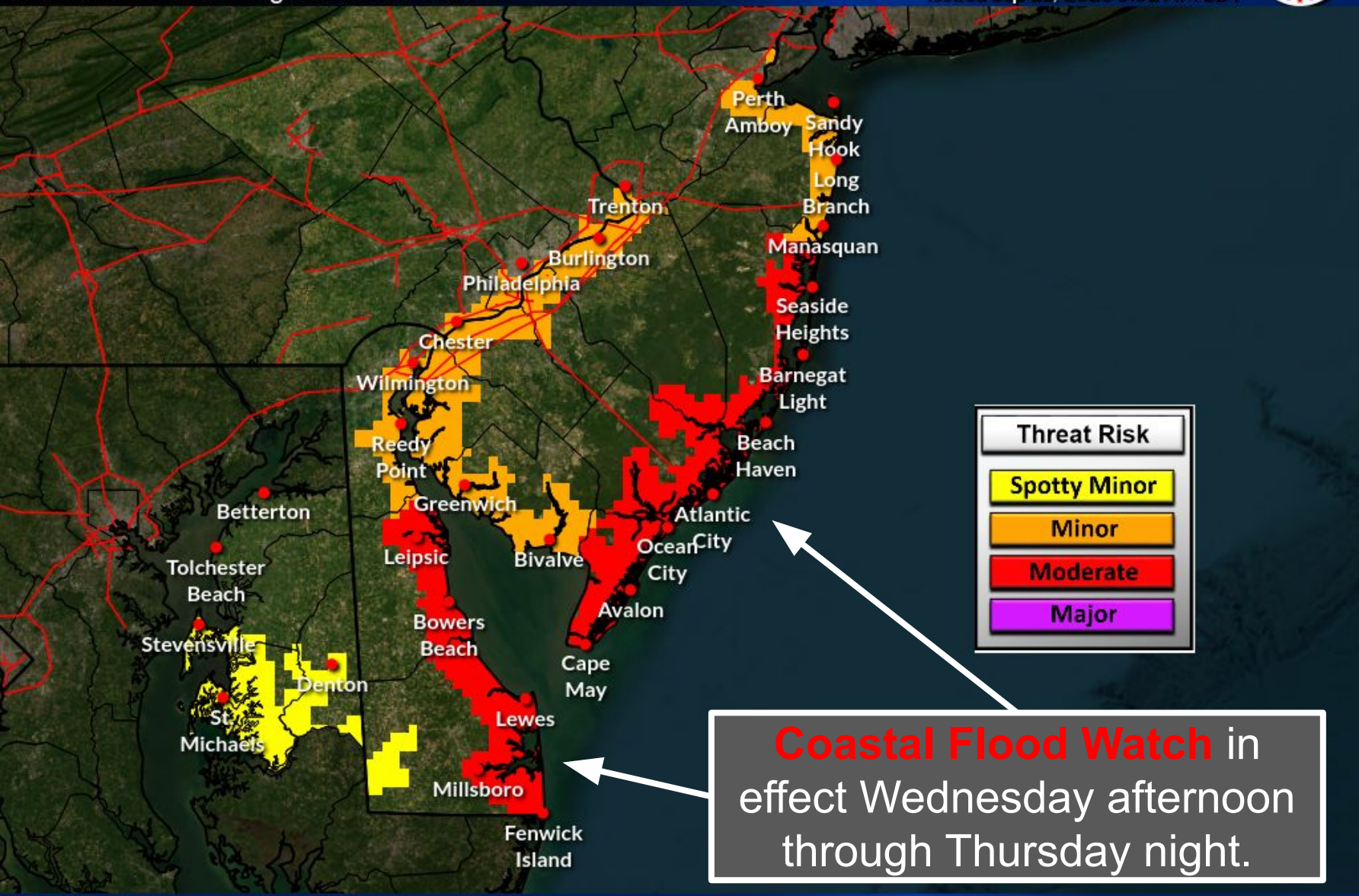
- **What:** Moderate coastal flooding possible. Potential for widespread roadway flooding in coastal and bayside locals as well as damage to vulnerable structures.
- **When:** High tides Wednesday afternoon through at least Thursday evening, potentially through Friday.

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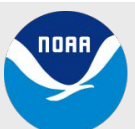
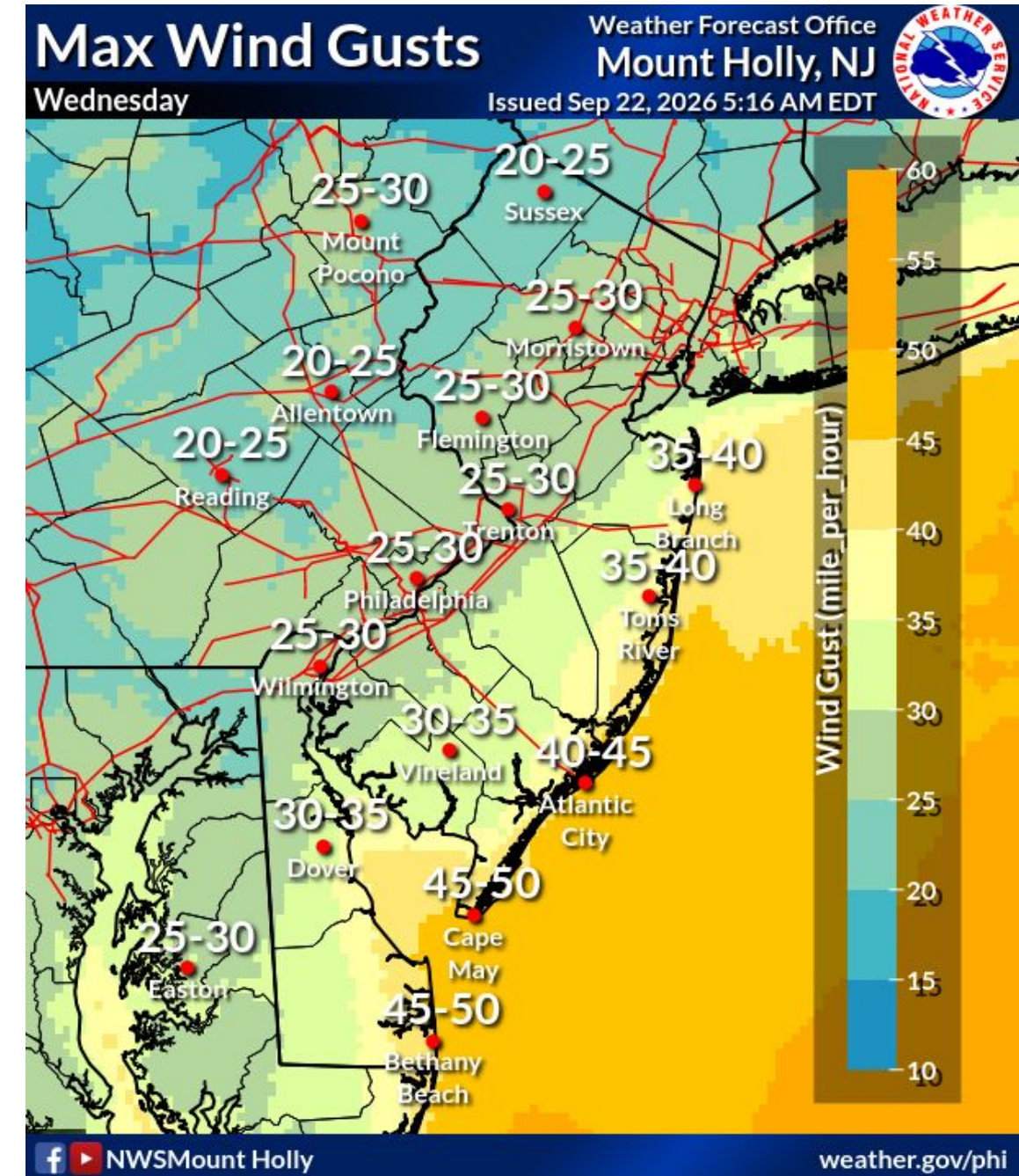
Maximum Wind Gusts

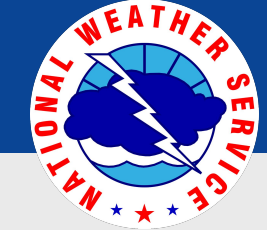
Winds this week peaking on Wednesday

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6:00 AM EDT

Key Messages

- Persistent northeast winds expected through at least Thursday.
- Strongest winds on Wednesday along the Atlantic coasts of New Jersey and Delaware, **sustained near 25-35 mph with gusts near 45 mph**. Wind Advisory in effect for Atlantic coastal New Jersey and Delaware valid 6 AM Wednesday to midnight Wednesday night.
- Wind gusts 20-35 mph possible inland.
- Gale force winds and gusts across all coastal waters. Seas building 8-15 feet.
- *Wind forecast Friday onward remains highly uncertain.*

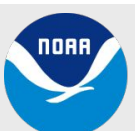


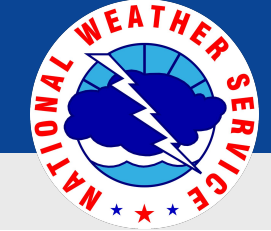


Summary of Greatest Impacts

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- **Multiple rounds of tidal flooding are expected this week** for portions of the Atlantic coast, Delaware Bay, southern Raritan Bay, and the tidal Delaware River. Minor flooding is expected to start with the high tide cycle this afternoon/evening with the **potential for moderate coastal flooding beginning with the Wednesday P.M. high tide cycle**. **The most significant impacts may occur for back bay areas** including Barnegat Bay and Shrewsbury River in New Jersey and the Indian River Bay in Delaware.
- Windy conditions are expected on area waters and coastal areas starting today. **Gale conditions are forecast starting tonight through Thursday** for the coastal waters, and may continue through Friday or Saturday. For the Atlantic coasts of NJ and DE, a **Wind Advisory is in effect for Wednesday**.
- There will be a **High Risk of rip currents through Friday** as well as dangerous surf with a High Surf Advisory in effect through Friday. Beach erosion is likely.
- Expect some periods of rain this week near the coast along with the windy conditions. There could even be some wind and rain impacts farther inland late this week but confidence is much lower on this as it will depend on the exact track of developing coastal low which is uncertain.
